'What then should we do?'

In our Gospel reading today we are reminded again of the message of John the Baptist, but this time we hear of his call to repentance, in a message that can sound harsh and uncompromising. John says that one mightier than he is coming, who will baptise with the Holy Spirit and fire, and will he will have in his hand a winnowing fork:



Winnowing forks are still used in some parts of the world, after grain is harvested the winnowing fork is used to toss the grain into the air, the wind then blows away the chaff the part of the grain that is useless, the heavier wheat (the good part) falls to the ground and can be collected. John answers the people's question 'what then shall we do?' By calling God's people to repent of their sins, to turn back to God and be ready for the coming of Jesus. Are we ready??
